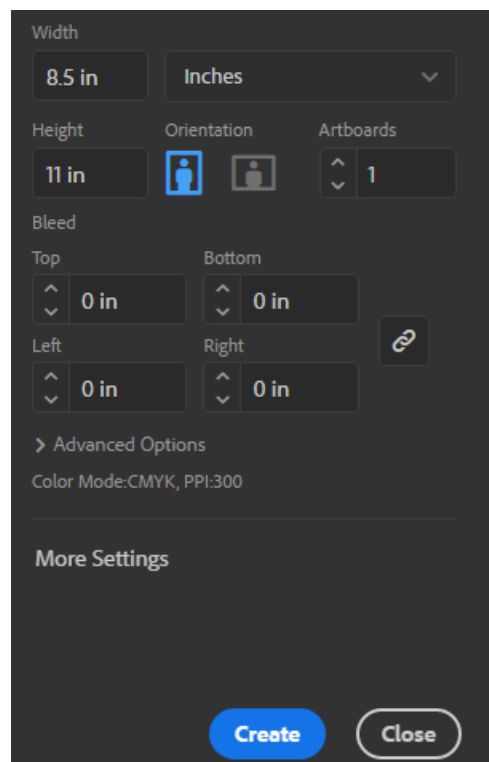


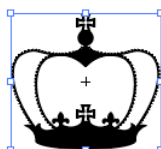
Adobe Illustrator® CC
Lesson 4 – Royal Crown Cologne
Skills: Symbols

1. File>New. Width = 8.5, Height = 11 and Unit = inches.
Click Create

2. Go to Window>Symbol Libraries>Regal Vector Pack and select the large crown:



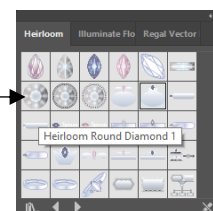
3. Drag the crown onto the canvas.



4. Right-click the crown and select Break Link to Symbol. Now you can change the color. Select the crown with the Black Arrow tool. Select the yellow color swatch to make the crown yellow.

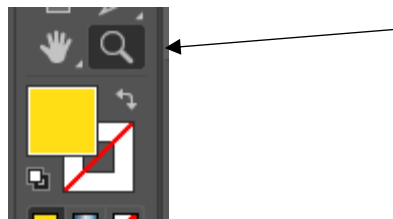


5. Go to Window>Symbol Libraries>Heirloom. Select the Heirloom Round Diamond 1 (1st diamond in the 2nd row)

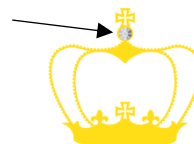


6. Select the diamond. **Hold down the SHIFT key and drag the resizing handles on the diamond to make it very small. (Holding SHIFT keeps the shape even)

7. Click the Zoom tool



8. Click on the artboard twice to zoom in. With the Black Arrow tool, place the diamond on the crown as shown:

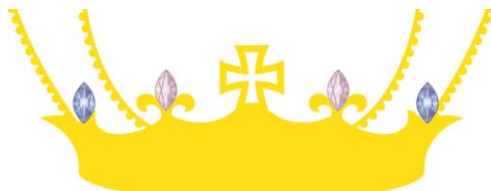


9. To zoom out, hold ALT and click the Zoom tool.

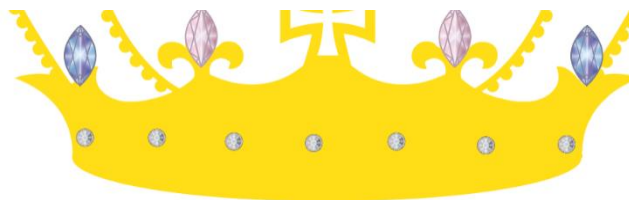
10. Select the Diamond Trillion 1 (3rd diamond, 1st row). Make it small and place it as shown. Then select the diamond and go to Edit>Copy, Edit>Paste to make a copy and place it as shown:



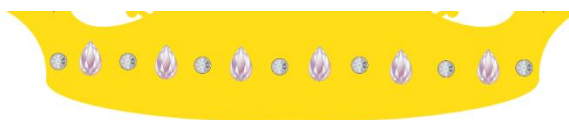
11. Select the Diamond Trillion 2 (4th diamond, 1st row). Make it small and place it as shown. Then select the diamond and go to Edit>Copy, Edit>Paste to make a copy and place it as shown:



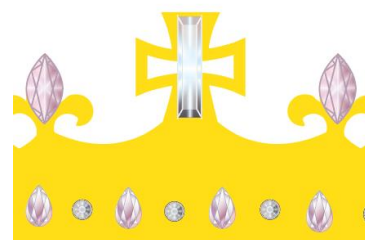
12. Select the Heirloom Diamond Round in Set 1 (2nd diamond in 2nd row). Make it very small. Edit>Copy, Edit>Paste several copies and place them as shown:



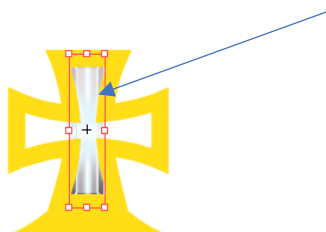
13. Select Diamond Tear 1 (1st diamond in the 1st row). Make it very small. Edit>Copy, Edit>Paste several copies and place them as shown. **If you select the diamond with the Black Arrow tool and press the arrow keys on the keyboard, you can move it a little at a time.



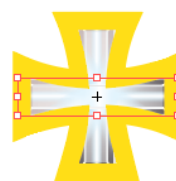
14. Select the Diamond Baguette medium (Last diamond in the 1st row). Resize it and place it as shown.



15. Select the diamond and go to Object>Arrange>Send to Back.



16. Repeat steps 14 and 15 to create this:



17. Repeat steps 14 and 15 to add the Diamond Baguette to the top cross too.



18. Select the Heirloom Diamond Round in Set 2 (3rd diamond in the 2nd row). Make it small. Then make 9 copies and place them as shown:

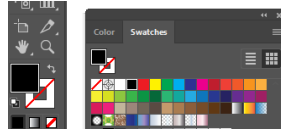


19. Select the blue Diamond Trillion 1 and place it as shown:



20. Select the Black Arrow tool. Draw a box around the entire crown to select all the pieces. Go to Object>Group

21. Change your Fill color to black:



22. Select the Rectangle tool. Draw a rectangle and place it under the crown.



23. Draw another rectangle and place it as shown:



24. Select the Rounded Rectangle tool and draw a rounded rectangle as shown:



25. Change the Fill color to white. Select your Rectangle tool. Draw a rectangle for a label.

26. Select the Type tool. Go to Window>Type>Character. Select any script font style (I used Edwardian). Type Royal Crown Cologne and adjust the font size as needed.



27. Type #9. Make the font size a little larger. Place it as shown.



28. Change the font style to a non-script font. Type 8oz. Make it small and place it in the bottom right corner and you're done!



Challenge

Use the Celebration symbols in the symbol library to make a birthday sign. You can make it however you want. You must use 12 symbols.
