 Skills: Clipping Mask, Line Tool, Transparency, Glyphs

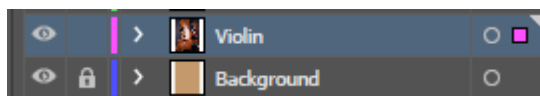
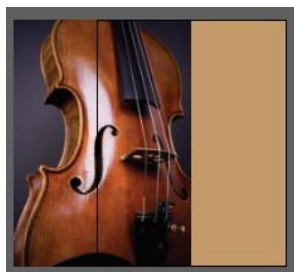
1. File>New. Width = 8.5, Height = 11 and Unit = inches. Click Create.



2. Set the Fill color to a light brown. Select the Rectangle tool. Draw a rectangle to cover the artboard. Rename the layer Background and lock the layer.



3. Create a new Layer. Rename it Violin. File>Place. Find the picture called violin.jpg. Select it, click Place. Click anywhere on your artboard to place the picture.

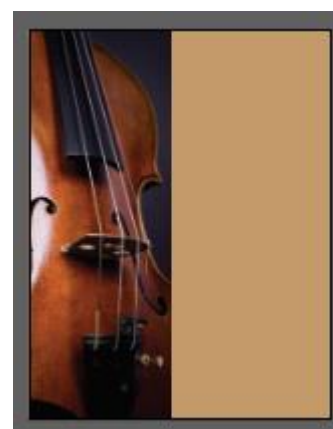


4. Stretch the picture with the Black Arrow tool. Allow half of the picture to hang off the artboard.

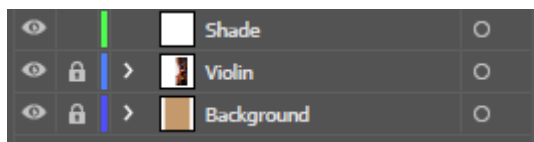
5. Select the Rectangle tool. Set the Fill color to None and Stroke to black. Draw a rectangle shape over the part of the violin that is on the artboard.



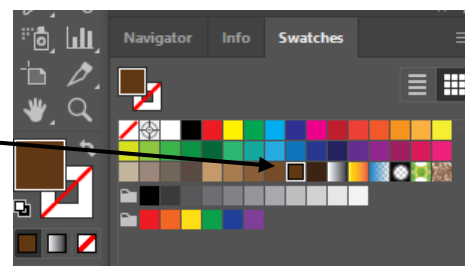
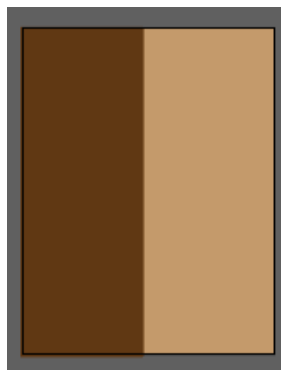
6. Select the Black Arrow tool. Drag a box around the rectangle and the entire violin picture to select both at the same time. This is so we can hide the part of the violin picture hanging off the artboard.



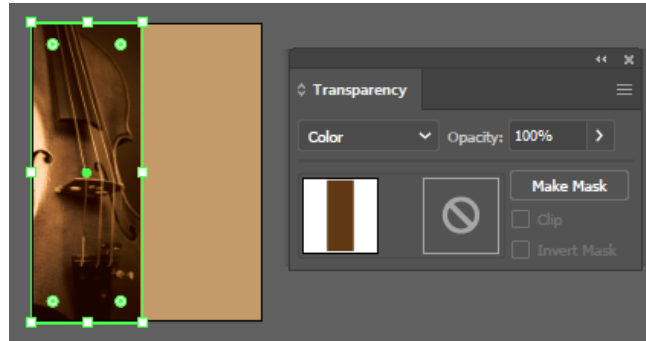
7. With both the rectangle and violin picture selected, go to Object>Clipping Mask>Make. You should have this:
8. Lock the Violin layer. Create a new layer. Rename it Shade.



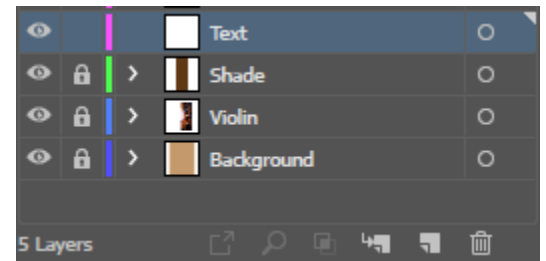
9. Select the Rectangle tool. Set the Fill color to a dark brown and the Stroke to None. Draw a rectangle that covers the violin.



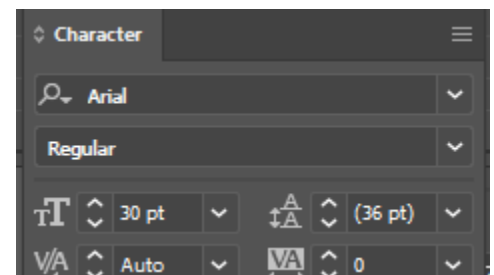
10. Select the brown rectangle. Go to Window>Transparency. Change the transparency blending mode to Color:



11. Lock the Shade layer. Create a new layer and name it Text.



12. Go to Type>Font. Choose any fonts you like and type Houston. Set the font size to 30pt. and type Grand Symphony, size 70pt. Set both to white. Place the text towards the top of the artboard. (Fonts used are Arial>Regular and Monotype Corsiva>Regular).



13. Type this in any font you like. (Or use: Arial>Italic and Arial>Bold, size 24pt.) Center the date.

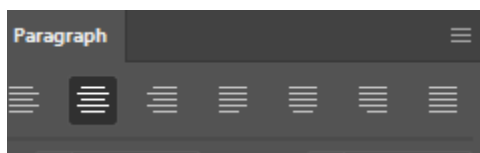

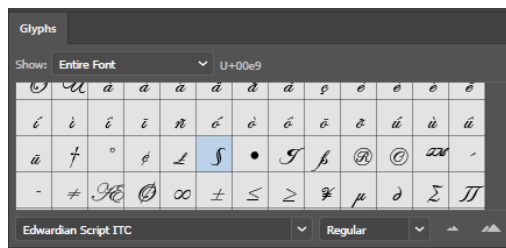
14. Select the date and time. Go to Window>Type>Paragraph and choose Align Center.



15. Set the Fill color to None and the Stroke to black. Select your Line Segment tool. Hold SHIFT and draw two lines for decoration. Place them as shown:



16. Go to Type>Glyphs. Change the font to Edwardian Script. Find the S shape letter and use it for a decoration. Place it as shown.



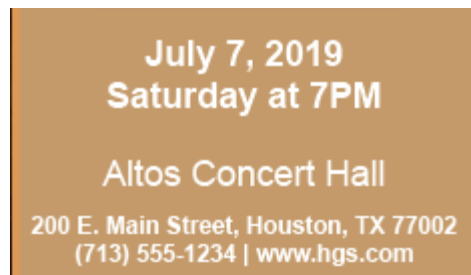
**Note:**

You can also choose the Arial font and use the S shape if you prefer:



17. Set your font style to Arial, 24pt and type Altos Concert Hall. Set the font to Arial>Bold, 16pt. and type the address, phone number and website:

**Note:**

To type the single line (called a pipe), hold SHIFT and press the \ key.

18. Finally, add another glyph under the phone number and website for decoration and you are done!
